Annual Meeting

The Association Articles of Incorporation require at least one annual meeting, which will be open to all members.

Meeting attendance and quorums are not addressed in the Articles, so it is possible to schedule a meeting and have very little or no attendance. Elections are required at the annual meeting; when one is planned and it is expected that all members will not be present, then provision must be made for written absentee balloting.

President Lodwick Alford has appointed a committee to plan the 1988 meeting: Ambassador Weston Adams is the chairman; Gil Alford and Pam Thompson are members. Georgia is being considered as a location since the President, Vice-President, and Secretary live in or very near Georgia, and since the Treasurer and Executive Assistant could get there with a minimum of difficulty. As plans progress, other members (not officers) may be asked to join the committee.
