Compiled from Guy Alford's work by Gil Alford, AAFA Executive Director

With this installment we begin to bring you the real content of Mr. Guy Alford's papers—the product of his research. Included in this issue is material from Guy's pages 2–24. Readers will find that some of what they see in these next segments will not be new to them remember though that Mr. Alford did his research 40 years ago. Had he published his work instead of dying he would have been a "pioneer" with much of this data.

Guy Alford used a mimeographed form on which to enter his information and as a result much of each page is taken up with the form. For your benefit his data is being extracted and provided in a more usable format. Our format will generally show Guy Alford's page and source followed by the name(s) emphasized in the article. Comments labeled "Comment:" are those of Mr. Guy Alford written just as he wrote them.

Comment: This is a record made and kept in England and the purpose, I assume, was to keep track of Englishmen living in the overseas colonies or rather plantations, as they were called in those early times.

And in this period, Barbados was a port through which traffic to and from the 'over seas' plantations cleared. Barbados was in the West Indies. . . .
