Compiled by the AAFA Census project team under the direction of Alicia Roundy Houston, AAFA Genealogist.

One hundred percent verification was done on the data to ensure maximum accuracy of this census report. All spelling variations are included.

We omitted information on ability to read and write and the value of real estate, as that information is of little genealogical value. [Editor's note: property value indicates land ownership, which can lead the researcher to land records.]

If an "Alford" was located in a household where the head of household had a different last name, the "Alfords" are in **bold type.** 

The following is a more explanatory introduction used in later versions:

For most subjects the age is expressed in years immediately after the sex entry. In some cases - particularly with infants - the age is expressed in months in which case the age column is blank. The age- when expressed in months is in the seldom used column immediately after age.

Color is shown after the age. It is assumed to be white unless otherwise specified.

Birthplace is shown with the approved postal abbreviations for states in the U.S. Foreign places were abbreviated such as: GM = Germany.

Column headings not meant to line up exactly over the data but rather to give position relationship

"Block Protect" has been used in this listing to ensure that families are not broken between pages. As a result there will be more "white space" than might be expected.

The family was recorded in this census as Olford but this was Wright, the youngest son of Isaac Alford and the brother of Winfield Alford of Gonzales County. Brother Hatch Alford apparently was missed in the 1850 census or was recorded under some other name. Hatch had married in Austin County in 1848. Sisters Sarah and Chloe both married Whitley boys. Wife Susan's maiden name was Grimes and she was previously married to Adam Kuykendall and George Norcross. Susan died in 1851 - perhaps in childbirth with daughter Susan born about that time who died as an infant. Wright married Maria Kemp December 8, 1852 in Washington County. In 1870 he appears as Right Alford in Eagle Lake, Colorado County. Where was the family in 1860? Wright and wife sold land in Austin Co. in 1856, 1859, and 1867, and sold land in Washington Co. in 1861. (BK 9172)
