For most subjects the age is expressed in years immediately after the sex entry. In some cases - particularly with infants - the age is expressed in months in which case the age column is blank. When the age is expressed in months it is in the next seldom used column immediately after age.

CYOB or circa year of birth is not from the census. It has been added to this draft to assist AAFA researchers who may be working with this draft document. It was calculated by the computer by subtracting age from 1860 and excluded for infants.

Color is shown after the circa year of birth. It is assumed to be white unless otherwise specified. In most instances the color was recorded only for the head of the household.

Birthplace is shown with the approved postal abbreviations for states in the U.S. Foreign places were abbreviated as follows: IR = Ireland.

AAFA NOTES: James M. Halford, born 1816 TN, and second wife Rebecca Crockett should have been in either Ellis, Johnson, or Tarrant Co. TX, in 1860. He supposedly died 1863 in Hood Co. but it was not formed until 1865/1866 (from Johnson). He is found in the 1855 Scholastic Census of Ellis County with four children between the ages of 6 and 16--Elizabeth, Martha, John C. and Jefferson. The girls would have been Kimbros, daughters of his wife's first husband, although they are listed as Halfords in the list. In 1870, It is assumed his widow is the Rebecka HOLFORD below whose enumeration we don't have yet.

If this is the James Alford in 1850 Humphreys Co. TN, he was the son of John T. Alford, born NC, and Nancy E. Rives/Reaves who married in Davidson Co. TN in 1829, and grandson of a Robert Alford who came to Davidson Co. TN from NC with his young family when John was quite young.
