By 1917, she moved with her parents to Hightower, Tex where she spent her preteen years. By 1920, the family had moved to the Beaumont, Texaa area in Jefferson County. In the summer of 1927, after the death of her father in 1924, her mother moved the family to Houston, Texas (Harris County), where she was living at hom (1628 Pierce Ave.) in 1930. In June 1930, Iva Dell eloped to Vinton (Calcasieu Parish), Louisiana and married a young oil worker, Marion Loftin (10/22/1896-12/1973). After marriage, the couple settled in Orange (Orange County), Texas. On July 8, 1930, after a month of marriage, Iva Dell took the train to Houston, to visit her mother. Shortly after arrival, the two ladies went shopping, and arrived back at her mother's home (a boarding house) at about 4:00 PM. Getting ready to return to Orange about 5:00, she told her broth William Earl, goodbye and asked where Henry Alsup, a longtime friend, boarder of 3 year and secret admirer was. She went into the dining room to tell Henry goodbye, when, in a jealous rage, he pulled out a pistol and shot Iva Dell three times in the chest (4:40 PM), at then himself once in the head. Iva Dell died on-the-spot and Henry died later at the Baptis Hospital. Nobody knew of Henry Alsup's secret love for Iva Dell; the family had always thought Henry, age 30, was like a big brother to Iva Dell. William Earl ran into the room just has Henry shot himself. Lela Alford, Iva Dell's mother ran from the front part of the house screaming, to the dining room. She then ran outside to get help, yelling the owner or the barber shop pacross the street, "He has killed my child." J.C. Howard, the barber shop owner called the police. Iva Dell's new husband, Marion Loftin, also a friend of Henry Alsup, was notified by phone, and he arrived in Houston about 9:00 PM that night.
