Jonathan Alford died on Sunday March 2d, very unexpectedly. Although he had been ailing for some weeks past no alarm was felt as he was not considered in a dangerous condition. He was an old resident of this place and was aged seventy one years. The funeral was preached at the M.E. Church on Tuesday and the remains were placed in their last resting place in the new cemetery south of town.

Sarah:

Family group record referenced earlier shows their marriage as Dec 25 1839. Perhaps the 16th was the date of the bond or license and the 25th the date of the ceremony.

Passed Away Saturday at Home of Daughter, Aged 91 Years.

---- Sarah A. Alford was born in Cincinnati, Ohio, April 28, 1820, and died June 17, 1911, aged 91 years, 1 month and 20 days. She was married to Jonathan Alford, December 25, 1839. Eight children were born to them, Mrs, Minerva Carter, Mrs. T. P. Mills, Mrs. S. P. Essex, James T. and W. B. Alford, who survive her, and Mrs. B. P. Head, Mrs. J. Feeman and little Belle Alford, who have preceded her, the last having died in infancy. Fourteen grandchildren and sixteen great grandchildren live to bless her memory. She was of English descent, her mother, father and four brothers having been born in England. Mrs. Alford has lived in and near Zionsville since her young girlhood and hence was well and widely known. She joined the M. E. church when 14 years of age and has been a constant and consistent member of the same for the past 77 years. Her husband died in March, 1884. Funeral services were held at the M. E. church at 2 p.m. Monday, conducted by Rev. H. C. Weston of Winamac, former pastor here, assisted by the pastor, Rev. A. P. DeLong. Interment was had in Zionsville cemetery, south of town. The public extends its sympathies to the

In 1860 he was enumerated in Pike County, Indiana as a Master Plasterer. Living with the family was a Francis Stedman-nine year old male and Anna Dugan-24 year old female born in Keutuckya music teacher.

From Boone County Atlas, 1878-

Mr. Alford was born in Stokes Co., N. Car. in 1822. His father, John Alford was a farmer, and he trained his family in that pursuit. He was the father of ten sons and two daughters, of whom John T. was the sixth son. Owing to the withering influences of human slavery, together with the unsatisfactory returns of his labor, and learning of the rich fertile soil of the Northwest, he resolved to sell his farm of 200 acres and move northward. In the fall of 1833, he sold his farm @ \$3.00 per acre, and moved into Pike Twp., Marion Co., Indiana. Here he purchased three 80-acre lots. At the age of 20, John T. moved to Indianapolis and learned the trade of a plasterer. He continued to reside there for twelve years. In June, 1847, and on his 25th birthday, he married Miss Sarah F. Gill. In 1853, when John's parents had become aged and infirm, he bought a farm and sold his business in Indianapolis, moving back to Pike Twp. where he took up farming. He remained there for five years, later moving his family including his parents to Sugar Creek Twp., Boone Co., locating on a farm 1 1/2 miles south of Thorntown. John and Sarah had nine children in the following order: Fannie, William M., Lillian, Josephine, Tilghman A., Emma, John W., Thomas G., and Annie, of whom two died in infancey, viz. William M. and Lillian. Mr. Alford later served as Justice of the Peace in Sugar Creek Twp.

LAST RITES FOR EARLY PIONEER

Funeral Services for J. T. Alford, 90, of Longview, Wash., who died here in the home of H. S. Ross, Friday, Nov. 19, 1927, were held in the Crosby Funeral Chapel, sunday at 1 p.m. Rev. Strong of the Presbyterian church officiated, and the burial was in the Geddes Cemetery. J. T. Alford was born in Zionsville, Ind., Feb. 5, 1847. Was married to Ruby Ann Brown of Finn, N.Y., in 1869. In 1883 he homesteaded in Charles Mix County, South Dakota, near Wheeler and resided there for 27 years. His wife passed away in 1910. And in that year he went to Canada and made his home with his sons, and moved with them to Longview, Was., in 1922, where he had resided until coming here Nov. 13, 1937. Surviving are two sons Harry Alford of Longview, Wash.; Brown Alford, Vancouver, Wash.; one daughter, Mrs. H. S. Ross, of Avon, So. Dak; 21 grandchildren, 10 great-grandchildren, three great great-grandchildren.

Charles Mix County News- Thursday May 19, 1910

Mrs. J. T. Alford died on Tuesday May 10th, 1910, at her home near Wheeler. She had been in poor health for a number of years but always uncomplaining. The funeral services were conducted by Rev. Camfield of Academy. His sermon was one great power, freighted as it was with faith and hope - flowers were on the casket, tokens of sympathy from kind friends - the remains were laid at rest in Pleasant Lawn Cemetery, Geddes, and so another pioneer of Charles Mix County has crossed to the farther shore and way beyond the reach of care or pain, out into the sunlight of an eternal day.

Ruby Ann Alford, wife of James T. Alford, was born at Fine, St. Lawrence County, New York, on Sept 8 1851; was married at Zionsville, Indiana, in 1869, moved to South Dakota in 1883 settled upon a homestead in Jackson Township, this county, where she resided up to the time of her death. She was the mother of theree sons, Harry B., Charles B., and Brown Alford and one daughter, now Ruby K. Ross. She was the only daughter of Rev. and Mrs. A. A. Brown.

Family members reported that Ruby was killed in a horse and buggy accident on May 10. The horse bolted and threw her from the buggy. After her death James T. Alford lived with son Harry and his family until shortly before his death.
