Lodwick's presence as well as that of several of his kin is documented in: National Society of The Colonial Dames of America in the State of Virginia, THE PARISH REGISTER OF SAINT PETER'S PARISH, NEW KENT COUNTY, VIRGINIA, 1689-1787 (1904; reprint Bowie MD: Heritage Books, 1988)

His birth date is estimated. His birth in VA is assumed.

There has long been a family tradition- reinforced by some DAR records- that Lodwick married a Rebecca Ferrell. Nothing has been found to support this idea. A North Carolina court record lists his wife as Sarah and some believe he married, Sarah the widow of his brother Goodrich. It appears that the daughters of Goodrich were mentioned in Lodwick's will. There is nothing to indicate the mother of any of the children other than William, Elizabeth and Jacob whose births are recorded in St. Peter's Parish, New Kent County, VA.

There is a will and court records to support the death of a Lodwick in Franklin County at about this time. A copy of the will is available on the website. Select him from the list at www.alfordassociation.org/will.html, or go direct to www.alfordassociation.org/wlod792nc.pdf.

This Lodwick is one of the most controversial ancestors we Alford's have. Look for frequent updates on this one as we can get them coordinated.

Notice that he has several sons who we know nothing about. One or more of them might be the ancestor of some of those proved by DNA to have a common ancestor with these folks.

There are some in the family who believe Elizabeth was a Cade. If that proves to be the case then her parents were Robert Cade and Susanna Crump. The records do prove that such a person was available for the marriage and from all indications the Alford's and Cades were very close. See also the record on Sussana Cade, the younger sister of Elizabeth, and the next supposed wife of Lodwick.

There are some who think Susanna was a Hartley but there is no evidence to support the idea. Others think she was a Cade with Lodwick turning to the sister of his late wife, Elizabeth Cade, to help with the raising of young William Alford. See the comments about sister Elizabeth Cade the supposed previous wife of Lodwick.

William Curry Harllee, KINFOLKS A Genealogical and Biographical Record of etc (New Orleans, LA: By the author, 1934) documents him, his family and descendants.

His will was dated July 4, 1794. A copy is available at www.alfordassociation.org/will_jacob_nc.html.

Some family tradition says he is buried in the Fulmore, sometimes called Ashpole, Cemetery in Robeson Co. NC but there are no stones or other evidence of his burial there.

The will of his uncle Julius Alford who died 1771 and the St. Peter's Parish Register combined prove him to be a son. Tax records also support this. Nothing is known to fix the date of birth. Some say born on 22nd and some say 1741.

The family moved from New Kent County, Virginia to North Carolina at just about the time he was born.

Tax rolls prove him as a son of Lodwick but there is nothing on date of birth. Like other sons who were apparently well to do on their own, he was not listed in his father's will.

Julius signed his will September 9 1819 and it was proved September 4 1820. A copy of the will was published in AAFA ACTION September 1989, page 31. It is also available online at www.alfordassociation.org/will_juliusc_ga.html.

The will of Lodwick Alford proves that he had a daughter named Mary and a grandson named Bailey Alford.

There is no valid information on the birth, marriage and death date of Mary or Isaac. The will of Julius Alford proves that he had a son Isaac and his birth could range anywhere from 1740 to 1770. Court records prove that an Isaac and Mary Alford, daughter of Lodwick, were married and that they were cousins.

His name appears differently in various records but in his father Lodwick's will, which identifies him as a son, appears to be Samuel. Court records dealing with him as Lodwick's guardian show both, Samuel and Lamuel, and marriage record appears to be Lemuel.

We do not have proof that it was Lodwick's Lemuel who married Clary Jones but he is the only one known to be around at the time.

The following is the compilers transcript of another related document.

This Indenture made this Twenty Third of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty four between KINCHEN ALFORD of the County of Franklin and State of North Carolina of the one part and SIMON ALFORD his son of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that I the said KINCHEN ALFORD for divers good causes _____ moving me, but more Especially for the natural Love and tender affection that I have to my son SIMON, I the said KINCHEN ALFORD doth hereby give grant Convey and Confirm unto him the said SIMON ALFORD to him and his heirs and assigned forever one certain tract or parcel of Land Lying in the County and State aforesaid and on the beaver dam branch and bounded as follows beginning at a poplar which is Jones and Thorps Corner & running North to Thorps corner & then running East Thorps Line and then south to Bunns Line containing one hundred acres be the same more or less.

The same to contain be the same more or less together with all the improvements thereunto belonging to enjoy free and clear forever and I the said KINCHEN ALFORD doth hereby warrant and forever defend a good Lawfull Right Title and Interest unto the said land and premisis before mentioned unto him the said SIMON ALFORD to him his heirs and assigns forever against any person or persons whatever holding or claiming any Rights Title or Interest unto the above mentioned land and premises. signed sealed and delivered in the presence of us.

The following is a transcript of a letter from Bryant Young apparently the executor of Kinchens estate, to his brother-in-law, Sippi Alford.

Louisburg N Carolina July 14th 1860 Mr. SIPEY ALFORD

Dear Brother

I have been looking for a letter from you for a considerable time but SIMON ALFORD informs me that. he recd a letter from you some time since and from what you wrote him you must have been under the impression that he was the [apparently an abbreviation for executor of your fathers will but I can say to you that, I am and that I have settled with all the legatees except you and I can say to you also that at this time SIMON recd your letter that, I was gone to Texas and went prepared to settle with you having got a New York check to the amount of your legacy but, the travel being so great. and being at such a distance from you I did not ___ you as I expected when I left home the nearest point that I was at from your house as I understand was Corsacanno (sic) I left home about the 1st of April and got home the 1st of June. & while upon the subject I can say to you that I do not like your country for various reasons. KINCHEN ALFORD came in last winter and got his part and the parts of the others in Georgia and I supposed that he would have written to you upon the subject as he told me that he wrote you occasionally and as I failed to see you in Texas I can say to you that if you desire me to send you a check for your part write forthwith and I will do so. I have sent several checks to other states with safety. A check can be obtained at from 1/2 to 1 percent discount and can be sold at a premium of about the same which will amount to about the same. Finally your legacy amounts to about \$1060.

As relates to your fathers Estate - I do not think it necessary to go into all the particulars but, can say to you that I done as I think my duty to all concerned. I do think that Mr. Alford's will as it turned out did not give Georgia Children a chance equal with his other children but I have no doubt, but, he thought he done right at. the time for he was a man that did not think of doing wrong But. the principal thing that, operated against his children in general was the gift- of a portion of his land to SIMON independant, of his an equal part, with the others in the balance I talked to SIMON about this thing and told him that he ought not to have that, advantage for the old man was in his dotage at, the time but, he seemed disposed to hold on I sold the whole of the property after the death of your mother. Land Negroes and all the amount, of the estate was eight thousand ___ or four hundred dollars should you wish to know any thing relating to the estate write me and I will give you the information sought. ___ your family is tolerable well at present. we hope these lines will find your family well. Write soon. Farewell dear Brother SIPEY ALFORD.

A fragment of an old family Bible of Emily Alford Cunningham provides the dates of birth of all the

children but Wiley Alford. They were listed James 24 Feb. 1804, Emily Louisa, 28 Feb. 1805, Allen 8 Dec. 1808, George W. 26 Feb. 1812, John Quincy 7 Sep. 1814, Kinchin Collin 10 Mar. 1817, and Emeline Allen 6 Jan. 1821.

Dr. James M. Edwards, on his own personal customized genealogy chart lists the children, and spouses, as follows: Allen, Wiley, John Quincy Adam m. Clementine Butler, Columbus A. m. (1) Martha Sumner and (2) Jenny Johnson, James m. Dorcas W. W. Pegg, Emily Louise Phoeriba m. Jos. M. Cunningham.

There is in circulation a notarized statement signed by Gertrude Alford Williams, daughter of Joseph Sidney Alford, son of James Alford, son of Cullen Alford. It is reported to be dictated by Joseph prior to his death in 1927 while confined to bed. (He may or may not have known what he was talking about and the fact that the paper is notarized means only that the notary saw Mrs. Williams sign the paper. It was not sworn to.) Anyway the paper reports that Cullen had five sons Allen, Wiley, J. Quincy A., James, and Columbus A and one daughter Emily Louisa Phoeriba. [Note that they made "Columbus" out to be a male but everything else points to being a female.]

The 1830 census supports the idea that Cullen had at least five sons and one daughter as that was the count in 1830: 1 son age 30-39, 1 son age 20-29, three sons age 15-19, and one daughter age 5-9. If son James was married in 1826 though who was the eldest son in 1830 - there were still five. Emily was married in 1823 yet there is still a daughter in 1830.

In her paper Mrs. Williams says Allen went to Alabama and lived with Emily and her family until his death.

It is possible that since George W. Alford died relatively young in 1834 (see below) and "Wiley who went to Florida and was not heard from" that some of those who were taking action to "document" the family did not remember them clearly and got the information about the two intertwined.

The above mention paper was witnessed by Dr. James M. Edwards whose own personal genealogy chart was attached. It is known for a fact that the late Dr. James M. Edwards frequently reported erroneous or at best unproven information. In his chart he shows Columbus A. Alford marrying Martha Sumner and Jenny Johnson. That was Columbus Augustine Alford b. 1850 NC son of Green Haywood Alford - another branch completely. In some copies of the chart someone has lined the spouses out.

Faye Lawes analysis of the Fayette County Tax Digests 1823-1834 support the idea that there was a G. W. Alford as well as a Willie Alford. It also shows that Allen Alford was still taxed in Georgia even though he was supposedly living with his sister in Alabama.

The "Georgia Genealogist Magazine" in an unidentified issue published the following: "Oct 16, 1834 In Macon, GEORGE W. ALFORD of the above mentioned firm of Smith & Alford*. He was a son of Collin Alford of Fayetteville. Had come to Macon a few days before he died, in ill-health, and died on the 13th inst., age about 22 years. Member several years of Meth. Church." * Smith also died recently and was buried in Macon that day. Their firm was in Houston County. Smith was only 24.

All evidence suggests that there were at least six sons and two daughters. The additional son being

George W. - maybe George Washington - Alford and the second daughter being Emmaline Columbus Allen Alford.

There is some conflict with daughter Emmaline. A Threadgill book published in 1983 shows the Emeline Alford who married William Treadgill to be a daughter of Isham Alford and Mary Brown and AAFA does list her there. However, a note in an old family bible of Walton Alford's sister Emily Alford Jenkins mentions "great uncle Threadgill, college president, wife Emeline,.." supports Threadgill as a part of this branch. But why call him great uncle when he was just an uncle? 8/19/97

Kinchen's death: Court record granting letter of administration for his estate was dated January 2, 1815 in Hancock County, Georgia. See below. Some reports show his death in Chambers, Co. Alabama but it was not open then.

In the Inventory and Appraisement of Estate and the Account of Sales of Estate, both dated February 15, 1815 it is apparent that Asenath Alford bought considerable property, consisting of Bible, household and farm items, stock and farming equipment. Included in a list of many other purchasers from the estate was one Collen Wooten- probably Asenath's brother.

Asenath's middle name is shown as "Deany" but it is suspected that is a corruption of a nickname- "Seany." It was used in the family record submitted by Joe R. Clement [see birth source for address.]

Her age in census of 1820, 30 and 40 put her birth between 1775 and 1790. Source of the "1786" is a 1986 family group record submitted by Joe R. Clement, Box 52663, Tulsa OK 74152 (918) 663-9153

The following was published in "The American Citizen Paper," Canton, Madison County, Mississippi:

It becomes our painful duty to notice the death of one of our oldest citizens in our county. Dr. Holcut [Halcut] Alford closed his mortal career on Sat. night Mar. 13, 1858. He was born in the state of Georgia and emigrated to the state of Miss. at an early day. After residing several years in the county of Wilkinson, he finally settled in the county of Madison, Canton Miss. where he had

resided for a quarter century or more. Few men succeeded better in life than Dr. Alford. Honest and industrious, he became one of the wealthy men of the land and yet his wealth never produced the slightest change in his life conduct toward his fellow man. In his domestic relations he was kind and affectionate, aimed to a fault whilst no man had the good opinion of his neighbors more than he. As a Christian he was a pattern for others and his friends at a distance will rejoice to know he died in the triumphs of the christian faith. When no longer able to exhort his children and friends to meet him in heaven he raised his finger toward the home he had labored to reach and pointed the way with eloquent action, when his tongue ceased to perform this offer. May his death be a blessing in its results to his family and friends is the prayer of an old and most sincere friend. Written Sat. morning April 3 1858. Editor.

We have a lot of "facts" about William Alford but none of them prove a connection here. There is a bit of conflicting data so we will lay out what we have here and hope someone can help unravel things. [There was another William Alford and son William Alford in and around Hancock County, GA and they must not be confused with these. That was another well identified and documented family.] Ole Kinchen Alford's will and the letter written by his son Kinchen in Georgia proves that Kinchen had a son named William who went to Georgia. Indications are he was in the Morgan-

Putnam counties area. There is supposed to be a family Bible which the compiler has never seen which states that William was born 1789 in Wake County, North Carolina. The date would fit without any problem but Kinchen was in Franklin County, NC. However, the proximity of Alford's along the boundary between Wake and Franklin Counties was such that one cannot use one county or the other as an argument against a connection. The Bible supposedly goes on to say that William married Mary Mason. So far we have seen nothing else to support the marriage or person.

A published list of Franklin County, NC marriages shows that Williams Alford married Mason Gay November 7, 1812 with Bannister Pipen bondsman and G. Hill, Jr. as witness. So far we have not found a William/Williams Alford in this area in 1820-30.

William Allford appears in the 1820 census of Putnam County, Georgia. He and his wife were born between 1775 and 1794. They had two daughters and a son all under age ten.

In 1830 there was no William Alford in Putnam County but in adjoining Morgan County there was such a family. He and his wife were born between 1790 and 1800. There was a son and daughter under 5, 2 sons and a daughter age 5 - 10 and 3 sons and a daughter ages 10-15.

That may have been a new wife in 1830 because there is a reported marriage in Putnam County between William Alford and Jane Kinnon- January 3, 1830.

The 1840 census of Morgan County shows William without a wife. The only female was under age 5. William was born between 1780 and 1790. He also had 2 sons under age 5 and 1 son age 5-10.

There was another William Alford marriage in Putnam County. March 4, 1842 William married a Rebecca Vining Thornton. He must have needed someone to take care of those babies.

We have not been able to find William in the 1850 census. Did he go back to North Carolina to visit his father?

Was Rebecca deceased by the 1850 census?

In 1860 William Alford, born in North Carolina and age 66 (= born ca 1794) is enumerated in Putnam County. Living with him is his son Green Alford, his wife M.A. [Martha Ann Arnett] and William's son Henry age 22.

The family Bible says that William died in 1882.

Notice that the will showed in the very beginning to be in Morgan County, but William state he was of Putnam County - further evidence that we should be careful about putting too much emphasis on one county or the other.

Note that his will's mention of stepdaughter Mary Ann Thornton pretty well proves the marriage to Rebecca V. Thornton.

Guy Alford commented: "On the day I copied this will, I did not have time to study the probate

proceedings or jot down more data. In glancing at other parts of the record, however, I observed that the nominated executors, the three sons of the testator, declined to qualify. That a man named Marshall was named, by the court and by agreement of the parties, apparently, to administer the estate.

Madison Morgan County Feb 1 1858 Dear Brother I have takin this opertunity answering your letter recd yesterday and and was glad to her from youall. I can sate to you that we ar all well at present. I am overseeing for Kollie that lives in Maderson at the hemss hill place on the road leading from Kinson to Maderson 1 miles from Maderson and 3 miles from Buckhed. My wages is all my bread cooking and washing and one hundred dollars worth of meat & 3 hundred dollars. I have 47 hans. Our crops of corn & wheat was very god cotton half crop. Corn is worth 50 cts pur bushel wheat one doller peak 8 dollars per hundred. I saw Mr. James Purdew that lives in 12 miles of Dangerfield he went from Green near Parks Bridge & he told me that filmore ?? was decd he sed he was not quainted with you but promas me that he wal call and see you when he return the sale of our parence tok place in 25 of November. Brother WILLIAM and sister ELIZABETH was thar. I cod knot leave my bisness. WILLIAM bought three Negros & ELIZABETH one tha sold high I think he said for Jim \$72.50 dollars. The estate mounted to 7500 dollars or thar about. I will state to you that my sun WILLIAM was mared the 5 of Janury he marred Jack Mullins daughter. He liv lass year & is get whar I live at Jordans when you was her. I have nothin more I wold be glad to be with you in Texas but I recon that I sall never be able to get thar my family is two large and is getin larger every two years tel it take all that I can make to feed and Cloal them. I have nothin mor give my respick to all you your family & take a part yourself Wright soon and dont let it be so long between times.
