The following is from the Bone-Pascoe & English Alford Family Tree found on Rootsweb (contact person--William English). I don't know who ordered and received the Confederate Military records (as stated below) but I do have Joel listed (from the Civil War Soldiers and Sailors System) as having been a private in Co. C, 10th Regt. SC Infantry. On a list from the Horry Co. Hist. Soc. site, entitled "Company C, Lake Swamp Volunteers (Horry), under privates, there are three Alfords---A. J. and S. Comparing this to the CW Soldier & Sailors list, I take these to be Arnold Bethel (mustered out, under age in 1861), Joel (captured and not heard from again); and Solomon who I assume is Levi Solomon (no notations). This leads me to believe what I wrote before about the J.T. (listed as I.T. on the SC Troops, Confederate Roll of the Dead (also on HCHS site) who died at the Battle of Secessionville, 16 June 1862 and was a Corporal in Co. E, 26th SCV was a different person from Joel (and we need to figure out who that was??).

If you look on p. 63 of the Winter 1996 AAFA ACTION and my article on Galvanized Yankees, you will see confirmation of some of the data listed below and his mustering out 29 Nov 1865, Ft. Leavenworth, KS. I cannot find anyone of that name born in SC in 1842 anywhere in the USA in 1870 (maybe changed his name or a spelling alternate, although he could write his name).

His "widow" Sarah E. Carroll Alford supposedly married Samuel Green Tyler by 1866 and had two children by him---Samuel Green Tyler born 1867 and Clarky Lunica Tyler born 1874 BUT neither in 1870 or 1880 is there a husband present in her household and in fact, in 1860, she is living in the household of Levi Anderson Jr. (remember that her son John Thomas Alford had Levi Anderson as his father on his death certificate--obviously not put there by John Thomas). John Thomas Alford, age 9 and 19 in 1870 and 1880, is listed as a TYLER in both census records. He is supposed to be the son of Joel Alford.

I guess Sarah thought he was dead and maybe that's what he wanted everyone to think. Who knows what happened to him??

\*\*\*\*\*\* JOEL ALFORD Alias: /Joel/

Upon ordering and receiving Confederate Military Service records, it was found that Joel Alford enlisted in The Army of the Confederacy during the Civil War. He mustered with the 10th South Carolina Infantry Regiment Company C, Swamp Lake Volunteers, at Camp Marion near Georgetown, South Carolina on July 19, 1861. He appeared present and accounted for on most company muster rolls. He was ordered detached by Lt. Col. Pressley to serve with Polks Corps,

Army of Tennessee.

He was a teamster in the Quarter Master Department.

Joel Alford was captured by the Army of the United States Union Forces at the battle of Missionary Ridge in Tennessee on November 25, 1863. From Missionary Ridge he was transported to Nashville, Tennessee on December 6, 1863. He then was forwarded to Louisville, Kentucky "For Exchange" on December 7, 1863. No exchange took place at that time. Joel Alford was sent by rail to Rock Island Barracks, Illinois. Rock Island was a newly built Union prisoner of war camp on an island in the middle of the Mississippi River. He arrived at Rock Island on December 9, 1863. He remained prisoner of war until October 17, 1864 at which time he enlisted at Rock Island Barracks in the Union Army of the United States for Frontier Service. Further information was found in Union Army of the United States service records for Joel Alford. These service records showed that JoelAlford had enlisted in the Army of the United States,

Rock Island Barracks, State of Illinois on October 17, 1864.

He was listed as 22 years of age. His height was 5 foot 7 inches tall. He had dark hair, a dark complexion and grey eyes. Occupation listed for Joel Alford was a farmer from Harris, South Carolina. At that time he was still a prisoner of war.

He mustered into the service of the Army of the United States for Frontier Service for a period of one year or duration of the war from the date of enlistment. He was enlisted by Capt. Henry R. Rathbone. Joel Alford was assigned to the 3rd United States Volunteer Infantry Company E... Joel Alford had come to be known as one of the "Galvanized Yankees". Galvanized Yankees were Confederate Soldiers who became Union soldiers to escape prison camps for freedom in the Western United States. He was paid a bounty of \$100 to enlist, with the stipulation that he would be sent out west to help protect telegraph lines and mail routes from Indian attacks. From October 17, 1864 until February 28, 1865 Joel Alford remained at Rock Island Barracks, Illinois. Even though he had been galvanized, he remained in the prison barracks known as the "Calf Pen" until such time that his company was moved by rail to Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. On March 11, 1865 his military company marched west on foot to Fort Kearny, Nebraska, 350 miles from Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. Joel Alford and Company E arrived at Fort Kearny on April 9, 1865. Company E was then stationed at Julesburg, Colorado, where the Headquarters of the Regiment were located. Joel Alford appeared present for March and April on the company muster roll.

He also appeared on a company muster roll as being detached as a guard at Nine Mile Ranch on April 26, 1865.

Beginning on May 5, 1865, for the months of May, June, July, and August 1865 Joel Alford was absent on the company muster rolls for detached service as guard for the O.L.S. (The Overland Stage) Company. In September and October 1865 he was present on the company muster rolls. On November 29, 1865, Joel Alford mustered out of the Army of the United States at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. Personal remarks made on company muster roll for Joel Alford: He was last paid on June 3, 1865.

Joel Alford never settled his clothing account. Stoppages were made on his pay for damage to the property of John Mattis and others for \$2.90.

Data on many of his descendants came from undocumented papers submitted by Susan Busby in 1987.

Susan's pedigree shows him born 1855, but in the 1850 census his supposed mother, Clarky, was listed without a husband.

However, in 1860 Clarky was enumerated with a 5 year old male, Henry, in the household, and no

evident source for a father.

In 1870 Clarky's household consisted only of her and 17 year old Henry J.

In 1880 Henry Alford, 26, a blacksmith, heads up the household with Helen E. as his wife. Susan Busby's pedigree was the source of our full name for her. The children listed in 1880 were Charlotte L., Levi T., and Martha.

In 1900 he was listed as John H. Alford 46 with wife Helen E. 41 and Charlott L. Hardie along with three Hardie grandchildren, supposed children of Charlotte.

In 1910 he was listed as John H,. 56 with wife Helen E. 46, daughter Ella 13 and two Hardee children: Perry D. and Willie. Perry had previously been identified as a son of Charlotte, grandson of Henry. Had they adopted these children or was the census taker mistaken in not showing them as grandchildren? Helen reported that she had given birth to four children and all four were still living. Where was Ella in 1900? We have one more child that Helen gave birth to.

In 1920 he was listed as John H. 67 with wife Helen 61, grandson Leon 12 and 18 year old Minnie Hardee who much be daughter of Charlotte. The census taker put "Hardee" in the column for relationship. The dwelling numbers are not legible, but enumerated in the house immediately before John H. and his family was that of William H. Alford 38.

In 1930 He was enumerated with wife Helen E. 72 were enumerated alone except for one boarder. They had been married for 58 years.

Mar 1 08 Email from Lynn Shelley:

I have been thinking about the identity of the parents of John Henry Alford and have come up with two scenarios. One is that he was actually the son of Joseph/Joel who died in the Civil War but according to info found on Hardee Family, this couple (Joseph/Joel and Sarah E. Carroll) had one son named Thomas before Joseph/Joel died in 1862. Sarah remarried but I forget who she married (Tyler, I think). Will check on that.

The other possibility and who knows how we could prove it but according to the same source (Hardee Family), the death certificate of John Henry Alford says that Levi Anderson and Clarky Alford were his parents. Susan Busby supposedly supplied the copy of his death certificate. There is a Levi Anderson living immediately next door to Clarky in one of her enumerations in 1860. He is married and has a fairly large family. Maybe it was known that his father was not an Alford which means he and his descendants were not Alfords biologically unless Clarky is indeed the child of Arthur and Clarky Sarvis.

"Yes, that is why I was surprised you did not have them. L.T. in that cemetery is Levi Thomas Alford, son of John or William (do we have proof of either name??) Henry and Helen Hardee (brother of Charlotte). I don't know if Maggie was L.T.'s wife because I have found two other wives for him (Fredy Ida Hardee and Sallie ???). I have to check his census records because he was in DeSoto Co. FL for the WWI Draft Registration and in 1910 but died back in Horry Co.??"

"Where did we get the list of children for Levi Thomas Alford (BK 4244, Arthur 1775 file) in the BK file? The reason I ask is that the list does not reflect what is in the census records. In 1900, as Thomas Alford in Horry Co. he has one daughter Rose Ella who later married Noah McDuffie Barnhill. She was born 18 Aug 1897, Horry Co. Her mother (Freddie Ida Hardee) is listed as having had 2 children only one of whom is living in 1900. I think this is the same person who is listed as a daughter of John H. and Helen in 1910 and is not living with Levi T. in Florida.

In 1910, Arcadia, DeSoto Co. FL, Rose is not in the household and there are two sons---Robert L.(Leon?) age 2, born SC and Charley L., age 3/12, born FL. His wife is Freddie I. although on his WWI Draft Reg. just a couple of years before, his wife was listed as Mrs. Sallie Alford?? In 1910, it says they have been married 11 years which would mean she is not the mother of Rose Ella?? or that they were married longer than 11 years. Levi Thomas is buried in Bayboro Baptist Church Cemetery and is in SC Death Records so I have to assume he died in SC and not FL but why was he back in SC after having been in FL for over 10 years?

Sudie Alford listed as a child in the genealogy was one listed as child of L.T. Alford who had died (in Horry Co. Obits from newspapers) and that was published in the Oct. 1905 Horry Co. newspaper.

Robert L., bom 1908 SC, is living with his grandparents in 1920 as Leon. I haven't been able to find L.T.'s widow or son Charley in 1920.

Where did we get the list of children and that he married Sallie Browning?" Lynn Shelley email Feb 28 08

In 1987 P. Susan Busby provided information showing that Levi Thomas Alford had (numbers shown are RIN from her genealogy progarm): Lyn (Leon) Alford 183, Roshie Alford 185, Sudie Alford 184 and Rose Ella Alford Barnhill 182. The parent MRIN for each of them was 52. Wife Freddie Hardee has RIN 181. Levi Thomas Alford also had supposed wife Sallie Browning Alford RIN 186 and supposed children Russell 188 and Thelma 187 both of whose parent MRIN was 53. This second wife does not seem practical but remains in this file for further study.

ancestry.com lists children as Etta Alford, Ella Alford Aug 1987, and Leon Robert Alford Sep 16 1907.

We did have, maybe still do, him shown as the son of John H. Alford. He was never enumerated as such. He first appears in the census in 1900 age 19 married to Annie, three years his senior. Because of the loss of the 1890 census we have no record where he was enumerated with his parents family.

In 1910 he, age 28, was in Horry Co. with wife Annie 34, Daisy 8, William A. 8, Ruth J. 4, and Bettie E. 1.

Until we made the link to John Henry Alford, based on Susan Busby data, the 1920 census was annotated "Top of the Line - no BK" In 1920 he w as 38, Annie 37, with Arthor 17, Alton and Joll W.
