Known Descendants of PHADA ALFORD PARKER MOORE

This is not the typical AAFA genealogy. These descendants of Job Alford are from a file created by John A. Rogers, AAFA #0544 who is the AAFA authority on Job Descendants. John has researched these folks to a greater degree that AAFA had researched most other Alfords. John also includes more information in his report than is found in a typical AAFA genealogy.

Nevertheless it is a work in progress and probably is not complete and with some error. The work contains many names but the only ones listed in the index are those listed within the registry system.

(18) Phada Alford, daughter of Job Alford and twin of John Turner, was born on March 18,1800 in Wake County, N.C. Phada grew up in Wake County, but moved with her parents to Jones County, Georgia in 1817. That same year she married her first husband, William Floyd Parker, Sr. (1801-1819) in Jones County, Georgia. She had one child by William: William Floyd Parker, Jr. (1/5/1818-1900). William Parker, Jr. married Drucilla Goldsmith (abt. 1822-1871) in Harris County in about 1839. William and Drucilla moved to Chambers County, Alabama from Harris County, Georgia in 1842, and were still there in 1850 (federal census). In 1858, William moved to Claiborne Parrish, Louisiana, and by 1870, he had moved to Wood County, Texas, where he was still living in 1871. Drucilla Parker died in 1871 in Wood County. In 1877 William Parker married his second wife, Rebecca Waller Goldsmith, widow of John Jackson Goldsmith, brother of his first wife. The family moved to Eastland County, Texas in about 1891, where William died in 1900. William Parker, Jr. and wife Drucilla had children: John Henry Parker (9/8/1839-4/22/1918), William M. Parker (1842-7/28/1864), Augustus Elbert Parker (12/9/1843-12/19/1910), Sarah A. Parker (1846-unknown), Phada A.J. Parker (1847-unknown), and Jesse M. Parker (3/4/1849-3/23/1934), Thomas H. Parker (1851-unknown), Emma Parker (1854-unknown), Oscar Marcelles Parker (2/2/1856-11/18/1934), and James A. Parker (1857-unknown). On September 12, 1823 Phada Alford Parker married Thomas H. Moore (1805-4/8/1881), probable brother of Elizabeth C. Moore, wife of John Turner Alford, in Upson County. Coincidentally, Phada's twin brother, John Turner, married Elizabeth C. Moore on August 31, 1826, in Upson County. Thomas was a member of Caney Creek Baptist Church in Jones County in 1821, the same church attended by Phada's parents. By 1830, Phada and Thomas Moore were living in Harris County (census) in the town of Mulberry Grove (Blue Springs area), where he was the Justice of the Peace for several years. They both lived there until their deaths. The 1840 census has Phada and Thomas living next door to her brother and his sister, John Turner and Elizabeth C. Moore Alford in Moore's District of Harris County. Nearby lived Phada's father, Job Alford. In 1850, they lived eight houses away from Job Alford. Thomas died on April 8, 1881 in Harris County and his buried near the town of Blue Springs in that county. Phada died on February 26, 1880 at the age of 79; she is buried with her husband. After her death, Thomas went to live with his son, Augustus Moore. Phada and Thomas Moore had the following children: Augustus L. Moore (8/7/1824-4/11/1902 b. Georgia), Sarah Ann Moore (12/2/1826-7/18/1895 b. Georgia / m. William Henry Hadley), Lysiar W. Moore (4/6/1829-7/16/1867), Cyrus Moore (1830-aft 1850), Thomas J. Moore (5/14/1831-6/27/1862), Frances C. Moore (1834- aft 1890), James Madison Moore (5/25/1835-6/4/1906), John Henry Moore (7/4/1838-7/3/1844), Caroline Moore (1840-aft 1890), and Eusa Angeline Moore (2/5/1841-6/1844).
