Obituary

BALDWIN Paul Franklin, 89, died April 9, 1996. Born May 24, 1906 in Clay Co. Tx. to Walter May and Nollie Inman Baldwin.

He is survived by his wife, Christie, of the home; a brother, Carl & wife, Marie Baldwin of Waco, Tx; sisters, Ann Nutter of San Angelo, Tx & Ione Willis of Ft. Worth, Tx; several nieces & nephews.

Paul came to OKC early 1920, from Sentinel, Ok, working at Bond Bakery. He served 4 years in WWII in the Navy on the USS Ranier, an ammunitions ship in the South Pacific. After the war, he was employed with the Postal Service, retiring May 31, 1971. Paul was a 50 year member in Natl. Assoc. of Letter Carriers, Branch 458; member of NARFE; and belonged to Masonic Craft 37; member over 50 years of Amity Lodge; also served several years on the Board of U.S. Federal Employees Credit Union.

He attended Penn Ave Christian Church where he was a member of the Men's Class.

Services will be 1:00 p.m. Thursday, at Guardian Midtown Chapel with burial in Memorial Park Cemetery.
