This is a tribute to pioneers in their professions and lives. Dorothy Allford, MD was born 6/24/1924 in Killona, Louisiana to Mr. and Mrs. Anna Singer and Murray Alford. She passed away on 12/27/2020 in Loma Linda, California, from complications of COVID-19 at the age of 96. She and her family love and were blessed to have her caregivers, Gina Morales and family. Dorothy was the last survivor, 2nd to the youngest, of 12 children that were raised on a farm in Raceland, Louisiana. Two siblings died as babies; however, the 10 surviving children went on to lead very productive and extraordinary lives.

Dorothy had a hard life. She graduated from Martin Behrman High School in New Orleans, then Louisiana State University in Baton Rouge with a Bachelor of

Science Degree and was granted a scholarship to medical school at Loma Linda University in California. In 1953, she completed her Master of Public Health Degree with a specialty in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, as one of only a few women in her graduating class, which was an extraordinary accomplishment.

Dorothy never married nor had children, but she loved her family, friends, and her home in Loma Linda. As a member of the Seventh Day Adventist church, she was devoted to God, her church and her community. She was also a published author about creation, produced two video documentaries on cancer from smoking, and researched baby birth defects. Her medical career of 40 years was in General Practice and Rehabilitation.

Women like her helped pave the way for all women who wanted a meaningful profession. Even during her years of retirement, she continued to attend the Loma Linda University Annual Post-graduate Convention (APC) and classes in the spring.
