Thomas Richard "Dick" Alford, 84, of West Columbia, Texas, passed away peacefully on Sunday, December 31, 2017 at Oak Village Healthcare facility.

Dick was born in Alpine, Texas to Erma Jolly and Herbert Lafayette Alford on February 1, 1933.
