Donald Charles DeVille, 58, of New Roads and resident of Baton Rouge, LA, passed away at his home on Saturday, August 25, 2012. Mr. DeVille was born September 18, 1953, in New Roads to Sterling

and Barbara Beaud DeVille. Mr. DeVille was a graduate of Catholic High School of Pointe Coupee and LSU.

He was a skilled and consummate professional; working as an auditor with the Office of the Governor and manager at Hawthorn, Waymouth & Carroll, CPAs, prior to opening his own practice in 1989 in Baton Rouge. Mr. DeVille was a member of the American Institute of Certified Public Accounting, Governor Roemer's Blue Ribbon Committee on Budgetary Reform and CPA for LSU's Tiger Athletic Foundation.

His professional work was only exceeded by his charity and community involvement, including an extensive list of civic leadership roles including treasurer, Louisiana Society of the American Revolution; treasurer, Baton Rouge Opera, Inc.; president, Sons of the American Revolution; president, Baton Rouge Sheltered Workshop; treasurer, Louisiana Capital Area Safety Council; and treasurer, Sigma Phi Epsilon Fraternity. He was also a member of the Boys Club of Greater Baton Rouge and volunteer referee for the Baton Rouge Soccer Association. Many honors have been bestowed upon Mr. DeVille for both his professional and civic accomplishments including Marquis' Who's Who in America, Who's Who in the South, Who's Who in Finance & Industry, Louisiana Farm Bureau Freedom Award and Louisiana Sons of the American Revolution Silver Good Citizens and Patriot Award. Mr. DeVille was strong in his Catholic faith and lived that faith by serving others in a giving and humble way, including his dedication and support of the sisters of the Congregation of St. Joseph. His relationship with the sisters also included membership on their Congregation Development Council.

As a devoted member of St. George Catholic Church, he served as a liturgical minister and was a member of both the church and school finance committees. His involvement with the Catholic church also includes membership on the Board of Directors for St. Joseph's Academy in Baton Rouge.

Visitation for family and friends at St. George Catholic Church, Baton Rouge, on Tuesday, August 28, from 9 a.m. until a Mass of Christian Burial at 11:30 a.m., with the Rev. Mike Schatzle, celebrant. Interment in St. George Church Cemetery.

Those left to cherish his memory include his wife of 28 years, Michelle Rinaudo DeVille; daughter, Ariel Elizabeth DeVille; son, Stewart Charles DeVille; daughter, Olivia Catherine DeVille; brother, Sterling Francis DeVille; and sister Debra DeVille Roesch. He is also survived and fondly remembered by many cousins, nieces, nephews and dear friends.

Preceded in death by his parents, Sterling and Barbara Beaud DeVille; and an infant son.
