Alice Fay Alford Lundberg Womick Whiting, of Wildwood, FL, loved to travel and "booked" her final trip on July 11, 2015.

She was born on June 28, 1941, the only daughter and youngest child of the late Nettie Jean (Tyre) and Ruel Jerusha Alford of Chattahoochee, FL.

Alice was loved, adored, and preceded in death by her two older brothers, Ruel Jean Alford Jr. of Winchester, VA and Leon Webster Alford of Trenton, FL.

Providing for three children, Alice was a very successful waitress for several Tidewater area restaurants, drove a school bus for James City County, owned and operated Alice's Artistic Beauty Salon in Grafton, worked as a legal secretary for a prominent attorney in Yorktown, and was employed for several years by Anheuser-Busch of Williamsburg.

It was her love for her family and historic home restorations that brought her to the beautiful Shenandoah Valley. While restoring her home on Main Street, she opened and operated her own thriving antique business in Mt. Jackson known as Even More Stuff.

With a great desire to preserve the local history for the town she loved, she also put her talents to work as one of the original founding members of the Mt. Jackson Museum before retiring to her home state of Florida.

Alice will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by her many cherished friends and family members, including the Ladies Red Hat Society and the Continental Resident Ladies Club.

In addition to her husband, Dr. George C. Whiting, of St. Petersburg, FL. Alice is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Terresa and Jay Linski of New Market, VA; son and daughter-in-law, Jon and Kay Lundberg of Phoenix, AZ; son, James R. Lundberg of Mt. Jackson, VA; granddaughter and husband, Courtney and Travis Cave of Maurertown, VA; grandchildren, Ryan, Samantha and Ian Pugh, Gregory, Sean, Julia and Holly Lundberg; great grandson, Ryland Cave, and many nieces, nephews and their families.

A memorial service is planned for October 17, 2015 at 2 p.m. at James River Baptist Church in Williamsburg, VA.
