Know all men by these presents that I, Jesse Alford of Horry District in the State y aforesaid, planter, for and in consideration of the sum of thirt dollars sterling money of the said State to me paid by George B. Smith, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George B. Smith all that tract or parcel of land, containing one hundred acres granted to William Snow, situated in Horry District, bounding on land surveyed for Vard Causey, and on William Graham's land all other sides by William Snow's land, and hath such shapes and marks as the plat hereunto annexed represents. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said George B. Smith his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said George B. Smith his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
