Enumerated on 1900 Census in Angelina County, TX with their three children and two stepsons by Melissa's previous marriage: Jim Allen 17 and Lewis Allen 14. In 1910 only Elton and Lewis Allen were still with J.C. and Isabella.

 Marmaduke "Duke" Alford born 1833, AL, occupation Farmer, married Dec 16 1858, in Toro, Sabine Parish, LA, Isabella "Annie Bell" McGraw, born 1842, TX. Marmaduke died after 1870, Probably TX.

In 1850 he was enumerated in Scott County, age 17 born in AL, with the family of Henry Robbins. In 1860 he was enumerated as M.D. Alford, age 24 in Sabine Parish, LA. As part of the family was wife Isabella and daughter Frances. In 1870 he was enumerated as Marland Alfred in Nacogdoces County, TX with Francis, Martha, Julius, Mary and Alsey E. Prior to the Civil War he resided in Toro, Sabine Parish, LA. In the Civil War he was a private in Company C, 27th Louisiana Infantry Regiment. He enlisted March 23, 1862 in New Orleans. He was captured and paroled July 4, 1863 at Vicksburg, MS.
