ROCKY MOUNT—Louise Matthews Fuller, age 85, died at her home on Saturday, September 27, 2003. She was the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. John Lindsey Matthews of Rocky Mount.

She is survived by her husband, Silas D. Fuller and daughter, Claudia Frances Fuller, both of the home; her son and brother, David Fuller and John Lindsey Matthews Jr. both of Rocky Mount.

Mrs. Fuller was a lifelong member of the First Presbyterian Church, Rocky Mount, where she was a Sunday School teacher and librarian. Among her many interests was the Tar River Connections Genealogical Society where she did a great work in research for

other people and the Liberal Arts Club.

A memorial service will be held at the First Presbyterian Church, Rocky Mount 11 a.m. Monday, September 29th, following a family interment service at Pineview Cemetery.
