On December 19, 1940 he married Delores Lee Kerr (Mar. 24,1924- Apr. 4, 2003) in Belleville, Republic Co., KS. About 1950 the family moved to Abilene, Dickinson Co., KS. In 2001 he lived in Abilene, Kansas. He was self-employed, owning a new and used car dealership, an H&R Block franchise, and Alford's Trailor Court. Martin died on February 23, 2004 in Abilene, where he was buried with full military honors at Abilene Cemetery.
