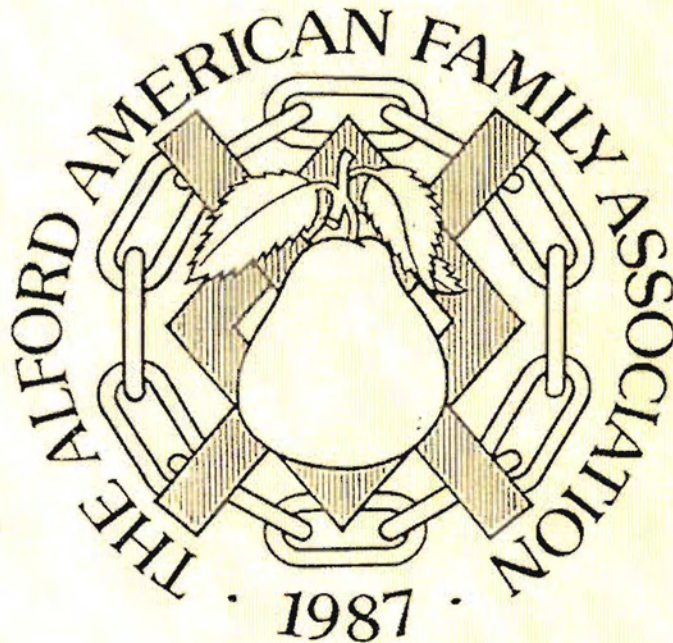

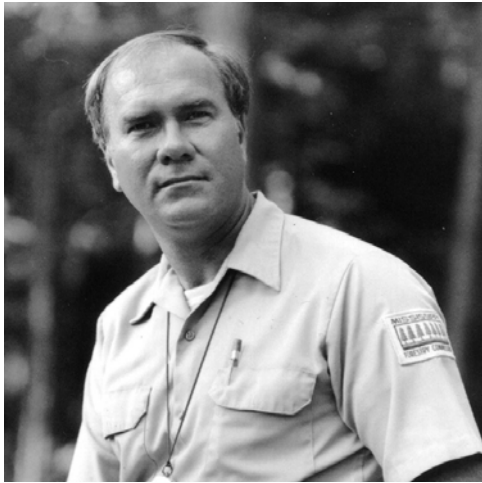
Using download instead of printed copies will **probably** eventually result in a decrease in dues for the applicable members. Those who do have the ability to

Membership

MEMBERSHIP REPORT

There are now 1,387 member families listed in the membership file of the AAFA. Most of the members live in the southern half of the USA. We do have members in Canada, England, Spain, and Australia. Of the 1,387, only 295 are what are called "active members" (those who are current in paying dues). Once you join AAFA and are included on the membership roll, your name will remain there for as long as there is an AAFA. Even your passing will not remove your name from the membership roll.

As a matter of fact, 253 members have passed away since the inception of the Association in 1987. Unfortunately, many times the Association is not notified of the passing and it may be years before the Association is made aware of the passing. That is sad because each deceased member is honored by having his/her name placed in the AAFA Memorial Album and if we don't know about it, then that cannot happen. The album contains the ancestry of the member, any articles published about or by the member and a photo if one is available. The ten or so binders that make up the Memorial Album are on display at each meeting. There is a membership list the AAFA web site at <http://www.alfordassociation.org/tafel.html>. Those members that have passed away are noted by having their names in italics. If you know of an AAFA member who has passed away but this list does not indicate such, we would appreciate you notifying the AAFA at alford_staff@alfordassociation.org. It would be especially helpful if you could also send along a copy of the obituary and a photo of the deceased. If you do not have access to email, you may send the notification to AAFA, P.O. Box 1297, Florissant, MO 63031.

Of the 1,387 members, 217 are marked as having invalid postal addresses in our membership file. We suspect that there are many more but we won't identify those until we do a mailing that involves these addresses. The invalid addresses have been used to contact members with mailings that we occasionally make and the mailing was returned by the post office as undeliverable for some reason. Some have a sticker with a forwarding address but most do not. So as to not waste postage in the future, we mark the addresses as "Invalid" so that we know not to try and contact them via postal mail. Please, help us "find" these lost members.

We also try our best to keep track of all members' email addresses, which is not an easy task. Apparently, there are some of you that change email addresses more often than some of us change socks. If you have recently changed your email address, postal address, or your phone number, please notify us at the alford_staff@alfordassociation.org address so that we may make the changes in the membership file.

We also encourage members with email addresses to subscribe to the AAFA OnLine Newsletter. The newsletter is published monthly (more or less) and contains Alford information in the form of inquiries, news stories, upcoming Alford reunions, etc. It is especially useful as the annual meeting draws near for tracking those who have made meeting reservations. Occasionally, it is used to notify members of items that need immediate attention (like the occasional sale at Family Tree DNA). The newsletter is free-of-charge and open to all members (active and inactive) of the Association. You can subscribe by sending an email to aafa-olnl-subscribe@yahoogroups.com. You do not need to write anything in the body of the message nor does it even need a subject line.

There is another online group called About_Alfords. Unlike the above newsletter, anyone can join this group and submit messages (only the owner or moderator of the OnLine Newsletter Group may submit messages to that group). You can subscribe to the About_Alfords Group by sending an email to About_Alfords-subscribe@yahoogroups.com. It is just as easy to unsubscribe from either group by simply sending another email and substituting "unsubscribe" for "subscribe" in the above email addresses.

As some of you are aware, the Association has a very keen interest in the use of Y-DNA testing as it relates to genealogy. Family Tree DNA (<http://www.familytreedna.com/>) offers Y-DNA tests ranging from a 12-marker test all the way to a 111-marker test. Once you have the tests done, Family Tree will look for matches within its extensive DNA database. But this will only happen if you sign a release form giving FTDNA permission to notify those with whom you match. If you don't sign the release form, you will not be advised of any matches that may occur nor will the person you match be advised of the match. That would basically eliminate the reason for the test in the first place. Your results will still be posted with the Alford Surname Group on the World Families web site (<http://www.worldfamilies.net/surnames/alford/>). On the "Results" page of this web site, "testees" are identified only by their GAP number (assigned by the administrator of the Alford Surname Group) and their kit number or surname if the name of an ancestor has not been supplied.

There are a total of 80 members of the Alford Surname Group. Of that 80, seven are females who are having or who have had their mt-DNA tested. The Y-DNA testing of the males of the group has already established that eight or so lines do share a common ancestor even though there has never been any kind of documentation to support a common ancestor. However, there are many more lines that have had no one tested as yet. The AAFA strongly urges all it male Alford members to have their Y-DNA tested. So far, only a small percentage has done so.

Mrs. Hencken, who was known professionally as Thalassa Cruso, was born in London, England. She received her Academic Diploma in Archaeology from the London School of Economics, London University in 1931, and subsequently became Assistant

Keeper of the Costume Collection at the pre-war London Museum.

From 1966 until 1969, she wrote and starred in “Making Things Grow!” for WGBH-TV. Following the success of that show she became a regular guest on the “Tonight Show” with Johnny Carson, published four books on gardening, and for twenty-two years, wrote a gardening column for the Boston Sunday *Globe*.

She also trained in field archaeology, and from 1933-1936 directed the excavation of Bredon Hill, an Iron Age fort in Worcestershire, England. The report on this excavation established a basis for much of the later archaeological work on British Iron Age sites, and led to her election to the Society of Antiquaries of London in 1938.

In 1935 she married Hugh O'Neill Hencken of Boston and Marion who later became Curator of European Archaeology at Harvard University. During World War II, she wrote reports on American public opinion for British Intelligence, for which she later received a special commendation.

After the war, Mrs. Hencken joined the Chestnut Hill Garden Club and began her career in horticulture and the environment. In 1961 she was made a Garden Club of America Horticultural Judge. In 1962, with two friends, she established the Amateur Horticultural Competition at the Massachusetts Horticultural Society's annual Spring Flower Show.

She was awarded the Medal of Merit by the Chestnut Hill Garden Club, for the Garden Club of America, in 1969, the Distinguished Service Medal by the Garden Club of America in 1970 a Distinguished Citation by the Horticultural Society of New York in 1970, and the George Robert White Medal of Honor in 1985 by the Massachusetts Horticultural Society. She also served on the Boards of the Massachusetts Horticultural Society and the Brooklyn Botanic Gardens.

She leaves three daughters, Ala Reid of York Harbor, Maine, Sophia Stone of New Orleans, La. and Thalassa Scholl of Boston; seven grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at two o'clock in the afternoon on June 24th at the Church of the Redeemer, 379 Hammond Street, Chestnut Hill.

Mrs. Jeannette E. Alford departed this life, Sunday morning, May 19, at nine o'clock, at her home in Plattville, Kendall Co., Illinois.

Deceased was born in the town of Peru, Clinton county, N.Y. in October, 1833. When she reached the age of two years her parents emigrated to Kendall county, Illinois. She was married to C.H. Tucker in July, 1854, at Aurora, Illinois. In 1858 herself, husband and two children emigrated to Kansas in company with E.M. and Levi P. Tucker, settling at Hail Ridge, June 2, 1858. She resided there until 1866, when herself and husband, with E.M. Tucker, moved to Mound City, where the two latter were engaged in the mercantile business and remained there until the promising town of Pleasanton sprang into existence in 1869, when they came to this city and were here before even a railroad had reached it.

To secure trained teachers to take up this pioneer work a summer normal school was conducted and teachers were given transportation to the West.

Miss Fisk was sent to Southern Indiana, near Veway. She taught in a log schoolhouse and also helped to organize a Sunday school. Later she crossed the Ohio river and was governess in the family of a Kentucky gentleman. Miss Fisk's father was a staunch abolitionist and for years had prayed and voted for the abolition of slavery. Though employed in a slave holding family she maintained her principles and denounced the unrighteousness of slavery. She did this and at the same time gained the respect and friendship of her employers. She returned to her home in the East for a short time.

In the spring of 1858 she came to Illinois to visit her aunt, Mrs. William Burt, and to teach the summer school in the McKanna district.

She was married to Samuel W. Alford of Plattville, Ill. Oct. 24, 1858. To this union were born one son and six daughters. The eldest daughter died in infancy; Charles W. died November 23, 1881; Mrs. Gussie Tallmadge died December 23, 1898. She leaves to mourn her loss her husband and four daughters. Mrs. Luaret E. Howland, Edgewater, Colo.; Laura, Amoret, and Nettie of Plattville and five

A memorial for Samuel W. Alford (1823–1915) is at Find A Grave, Plattville Cemetery, Plattville, Kendall Co., IL. The obituary says he was buried in CA.

In the Winter 2000 issue of *AAFA ACTION*, we published '[Alford' Bible Records](#), by Lynn Shelley, AAFA #0484, an article about Orman Alford's family. Tony Kirk, AAFA #1005, contributed these old obituaries for this family.

In the Bible record referenced above, Samuel's birth date is listed as June 13, 1832, but the obituary and the 1900 census list the month as January.

We have Y-DNA from several descendants of John Alford and the Y-DNA of descendants of ten other branches of the family. These branches are not connected to John with the traditional genealogical data, however it is reasonable to believe that they will prove to connect somewhere with in this John Alford branch. The other ten branches are: CHA790NC, CLA890GA, EXU788NC, ISH755NC, JAM715VA, JAM749NC, JOH801NC, JOH816NC, SAL716VA, & WIL760NC. **We need Y-DNA tests of as many male Alfords as possible.**

1. **John Alford #4656** b. about 1645, probably Virginia, m. **Wife is Unknown #4657**. John died Mar 14 1710, New Kent Co., VA.

The late Tressie Bowman, publisher of the ALFORD FAMILY BULLETIN in a family group record provided to AAFA used the St. Peter's Parish Register and Boddie to compile a family as is shown in this record. Although the church record does prove a John Alford had the children listed there is nothing to prove it was the John who died in 1710.

Please note that there is no proof that James was the son of John. There are some who make a William Alford the father of James. It is true that there was a William Alford in the area at the same time who had about equal circumstances as James. We lean to John but you can take your pick.

There are important notes at the records of most of the children. Please don't draw any conclusions about them without first reviewing those records.

John's date of birth is nothing more than a guess- as is his place of birth. See also Boddie, John HISTORICAL SOUTHERN FAMILIES, Vol XII, page 57-58.

His death was reported in The Parish Register of Saint Peter's New Kent County, Virginia 1680-1787 published by The National Society of The Colonial Dames of America in the state of Virginia, 1904, Richmond. Reprinted by Heritage Books, 1988

The Colonial Dames has accepted John Alford as a supplemental ancestor of one of our AAFA members.

The following is a summary of the John Alford entries in the St. Peter's Parish Vestry book (V) and Register (R). Obviously covers at least two John Alfords. Original spelling is used.

8th day of a month not identified in 1686 allowed John Alferd for nursing a bastard Child until December 17 next 1000 pounds. (Vpg 7)

October 5, 1687 allowed Mr. John Alford for nursing a bastard Child 1000 pounds. (Vpg 11)

October 5, 1687 in a separate entry "It is ordered that Mr Jno Allford now having a bastart Child in keeping and having Recd two thousand [pounds?] tobb and Ck doth now discharte ye Parish from ye sam [] and is Likewise ordered by this vestry to keep the Sd Child to serve according to Law and to discharge the Parish from ye same." (Vpg 13)

October 3, 1698 "Mr John Alford aploying him selfe to this vestry for help to Cleer the Roades in his prescits is ordered all the tithables which formerly belonged to David Clarkson and with in his preseits." (Vpg 62)

March 4 1702 "whereas Mr John Alford and Mr. will major mad[] Complaint to this vestry that they have never had their Lands possesioned according to Law the orders being Lodged in the hands of Coll John Lightfoot who never put the Same in Execution Therefore ordered that John wilson, John Lightfoot Esq Mr. will major mr John Alford Dan Parke Esq and William Millington forth with goe on prossessioning and rea marke Each others bounds and make returne of this order to the next vestrey." (Vpg 82,83)

Sometime in May 1708 - William Hodkison servant of Mr. John Alfrods deceased. (Vpg 432 and Rpg 61).

March 14 1710 John Alford Senr Departed this Life. (Rpg 53)

August 4 1717 Frances Daughter of John Alford born. (Vpg 449 repeats Vpg 450 and Rpg 78 repeats Rpg 74)

November 18 1717 (two entries) (Vpg 164) Allowed John Alford for Mary Design &. 300 pounds.

Allowed John Alford for Carrying away Rebb Barber 600 pounds.

June 22 1719 Cuffee A Negro of John Alford born. (Vpg 450 and Rpg 74)

July 1 1719 Elizabeth Daughter of John Alford born. (Vpg 450 and Rpg 74)

June 21 1721 Lucy a negro belonging to John Alford born. (Vpg 450 and Rpg 74)

August 21 1723 Isaac Alford Son of John Alford departed this life. (Vpg 420 and Rpg 53)

January 1726 Jenny a negro girl of John Alford born. (Vpg 451 and Rpg 75)

May 2 1726 John Alford Dyed. (Vpg 420 and Rpg 54)

() "James Alford, son of John Alford, was probably born about 1685-90, and died in New Kent Co. between 1721 (his last appearance in the records of St. Peter's Parish, p. 180, and 1735, when his sons Lodwick, Julius and Goodrich are shown as tithables, but he was not mentioned (St. Peter's P.R., p. 246). His wife's name is unknown, but St. Peter's Parish Register shows that he had the following children." [As listed in this family record. It is pretty obvious here that they really don't say when or where James was born or died.] There are some who believe that he went to North Carolina with sons Lodwick and Julius.

WHAT IS NOT!

Northen, William J., Ed (Ex-Governor of Georgia), "Men of Mark in Georgia." (Spartanburg, SC: The Reprint Company, 1974) This "source" contains sketches on Drewry Cade Alford, Columbus Augustus Alford, and Julius C. Alford. "The three immigrants were: William, born in London in 1608, who, with his two brothers, Benedictus and Alexander, came to Boston. William had a son Benjamin, born in 1650; Benjamin a son James, born in 1691; James had a son James William Zion Alford, born about 1730. It is not certain whether he was born in Boston or in North Carolina, for his father moved to North Carolina about that time." END OF WHAT IS NOT

We have enough information on the New England families to know that there were TWO "Alford" brothers, Benedictus (Benedict) and Alexander (Alvord) who came to Boston with their sister. We know about William, Benjamin and James, but William was probably not a brother and that James was not the same James as the progenitor of the southern Alford's. Bernard Suttler, who wrote the articles, apparently had not heard of the Alford's who had been in Virginia since before the brothers arrived in Boston, nor had he heard about the St. Peter's Parish Church records which document James' presence there. For over 25 years we have been looking for any shred of evidence to prove a James William Zion Alford but have not succeeded. There were James Alford's, William Alford's, and Zion or Sion Alford's, but never one person with all three names.

When we became involved in the Alford search in the early 1980's folks were using the 1691 birth of the New England James Alford for the James Alford of Virginia. Note that Boddie above waffled with "about 1685-90." To eliminate the waffle and move away from the erroneously used 1691 we began using the date of about 1687. There is not anything to prove that.

September 29, 1718 as surveyor of ye highways. (pg 168)

September 29 1721 allowed 76 1/2 pounds for an Overlist. (pg 180)

The Vestry Book and Register of St. Peter's Parish, New Kent and James City Counties, Virginia, 1706-1786 as transcribed and edited by C.G. Chamberlayne shows that James, son of James Alford, was born February 7th 1713 and Christened April 12 1713. We have no further record of him until July 24 1761 when he was granted 610 acres on Crooked Creek, then in Granville Co. The land joined that of Lodwick Alford. It was surveyed for him Dec 2 1760 and he sold the land to John Ferrell Jun 19 1770.

He paid taxes in Bute Co. in 1766 along with Goodrich, Julius, Lodwick and Lodwick, Jr.

In 1767 he apparently served as some official capacity in the county because, as James Alford Esquire he "returned his list of Taxabales."

The St. Peter's Parish Register proves that John was married to Grace and his death date. It shows that they had children: Frances, Isaac, Elizabeth, Unity and Charity. It also shows that Grace later married Michael Harfield. John Alford identified the last three children in his will signed May 1, 1726. At that time John owned nine slaves and they were given to the daughters in the will. In a court case in Halifax County, September 1771, John Bates was seeking a settlement involving the slaves and the will was introduced as evidence. The court case goes on to say "We find that a certain John Bates intermarried with Elizabeth Alford a legatee therein named . . ."

His birth date is estimated. His birth in VA is assumed.

There has long been a family tradition- reinforced by some DAR records- that Lodwick married a Rebecca Ferrell. Nothing has been found to support this idea. A North Carolina court record lists his wife as Sarah and some believe he married, Sarah the widow of his brother Goodrich. It appears that the daughters of Goodrich were mentioned in Lodwick's will. There is nothing to indicate the mother of any of the children other than William, Elizabeth and Jacob whose births are recorded in St. Peter's Parish, New Kent County, VA.

There is a will and court records to support the death of a Lodwick in Franklin County at about this time. A copy of the will is available on the website. Select him from the list at www.alfordassociation.org/will.html, or go direct to www.alfordassociation.org/wlod792nc.pdf.

This Lodwick is one of the most controversial ancestors we Alford have. Look for frequent updates on this one as we can get them coordinated.

Notice that he has several sons who we know nothing about. One or more of them might be the ancestor of some of those proved by DNA to have a common ancestor with these folks.

There are some in the family who believe wife Elizabeth was a Cade. If that proves to be the case then her parents were Robert Cade and Susanna Crump. The records do prove that such a person was available for the marriage and from all indications the Alford and Cades were very close. See also the

record on Sussana Cade, the younger sister of Elizabeth, and the next supposed wife of Lodwick. There are some who think wife Susanna was a Hartley but there is no evidence to support the idea. Others think she was a Cade with Lodwick turning to the sister of his late wife, Elizabeth Cade, to help with the raising of young William Alford. See the comments about sister Elizabeth Cade the supposed previous wife of Lodwick.
