A Petition of February 19, 1838 by Raleigh Hazard shows that he married Rebecca Alford... and that their children are: Lucy Ann, Julius H., Sarah and Dianah. He states that Rebecca died about the year 1833 and left property.

Julius H. Alford releases Henry Melton from tutorship, November 14, 1841.
