We would like to publish some of the charts we have assembled from bibles, wills and census records, altho some are far from complete, still someone might have the missing link needed to complete the chart.

Would you like charts printed and if so can you furnish one from your line? Your comments re this will be gratefully appreciated.

One object of the ALFORD FAMILY BULLETIN was to prove that those of the name in Virginia were descendants of a certain Benjamin Alford of Boston, who with Andrew Belcher were owners of a Brigatine "William and Mary of Boston" which entered the upper district of the James River between 1701 and 1702. Also that a John Alford on the rent roll 1704 of New Kent County, Virginia was of the same New England family.

Lodowick Alford appears on rolls of St. Peter's Church, New Kent County, Virginia and descendants of that name also appear in the North Carolina and Georgia records where we believe our Jacob Alford lived at one time before migrating to St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana in 1809.

One line has been established on a William Alford of Warwick County, Virginia, as the ancestor of this Jacob Alford of St. Tammany Parish, La., so far we are not convinced due to the similarity of names in present descendants of those in New Kent County, Virginia, which we feel sure are of the Boston branch.

Since mail is heavy at the Christmas holiday season, we expect to change the publication date so that the fall issue will come out about the first of October or November with the spring issue about six months earlier.

We would appreciate your advice when material published in the ALFORD FAMILY BULLETIN, fits into your line, so we may keep our charts current.

I do appreciate each and every letter received and only wish I could find enough time to answer each one.
