The initial aim of this bulletin was to prove the ancestor of Jacob ALFORD (who settled c1809/10 in St. Tammany Parish(County), Louisiana, and his wife Frankey B. Seaborn, who survived him on the 1830 census of that Parish.

An additional aim was to prove that those Alford's mentioned in the St. Peter's Parish Register, New Kent County, Virginia were descendants of the family called "Alvord" by those early immigrants to New England from England where the name had been ALFORD.

One of the immigrants from England, namely Alexander Alvord (my own ancestor) married Mary Voare, a daughter of Richard Voare who in his will of 1683 left "5 shillings to Thomas ALFORD, son of my daughter Mary ALFORD, now deceased".

Unproven but possible is that the Benjamin Alford, of Boston, co-owner of the boats "William and Mary of Boston" and "Lyon of Boston" who came up the James River in Virginia 1701/2 was either father or a close relative of those named in the St. Peter's Parish Register.

We give herein the charts of those earliest of the name ALVORD/ALFORD of New England and will continue with charts compiled from a manuscript loaned us by a descendant of one mentioned therein, namely Mrs. Jesse T. Price, whose ancestor was James Stephan Alford and wife Matilda Bagwell..

It is hoped that any corrections to any of the charts would be forwarded to us so we could advise our mailing list of such errors. We have not attempted to correct the manuscript preferring to publish it as submitted.

Cooperation in genealogical research is a must and makes the research ultimately less costly. Therefore we crave your fullest cooperation.

Alexander Alvord, bp. 15 October 1620? Bridport, County Dorset, England, (was a son of Thomas ALFORD, Bridport, County Devon and Whitestaunton, County Somerset, England, who married in Ashill, County Somerset, England, on 11 May 1618, Joan, daughter of John Hawkins). Alexander and brother Benedictus changed the spelling to Alvord when they came to New England. Alexander Alvord came from England between 1636/1640 settling at Windsor, Conn., 1645 was at Northampton, Mass., 1661. He married 29 October 1646 Mary Voare/Vore (b. 6 Jul. 1617 d. bf. 1683 (daughter of Richard Vore/Voare). Alexander Alvord, died 3 October 1687 Northampton, Mass., where he took Oath of Allegiance, 8 February 1678.

Benedictus Alford (Alvord) b. England c1621 died 23 April 1683 was an early settler of Windsor, Conn., and was a Sgt. in the Pequot War or Expedition under Capt. Mason of Windsor. He married c. 1640 Jane Newton. Benedictus joined the church in Windsor 1641, was a juror April 1643 and March 1646 a constable at Windsor 1666. They had the following children;
