Yes, I know Charles Holloman and William Mitchiner. I talked with Charles Holloman about the Alfords before I sent you the last material. He doesn't know anything much. He works <sup>the</sup> historical side of things - Wm<sup>m</sup> Mitchiner on the genealogical. Wm<sup>m</sup> married my cousin and I have some cousins that are his cousins, though he is of no blood relation to me. I had a long chat with him over the telephone last night. He and I agree on Lod<sup>k</sup> who died in Franklin as being the Old Lod<sup>k</sup>.

If you find a will or settlement of estate for the one who died in Ga. in 1789, I surely would like to know exactly <sup>what</sup> it says.

that James Lodwick is who you say he is.


I don't have an abstract of Lodwick's 1820
