1. **John Monroe "Jack" Kinabrew, Jr.** b. Aug 3 1914, New Orleans, Orleans Parish, LA, m. (1) Jun 19 1936, in Johnson Station, Pike Co., MS, **Bessie June Coney**, b. Jun 30 1915, Covington, St. Tammany Parish, LA, d. Jan 13 1986, New Orleans, Orleans Parish, LA, m. (2) after 1986, **Eileen O'Brien Kemp**. Jack died Sep 19 1998, New Orleans, Orleans Parish, LA. Jack was the president of his own Hardware Supply Business. It was he who began the AAFA photo archives. Obituary: Jack retired as the president of Standard Supply and Hardware Co. He graduated from Rugby Academy and Tulane University School of Business. He was a member of the Southern Yacht Club and Tally Ho Club and a former member of the Rex organization, the Stratford Club and the Bienville Club. He also was a member of the Parish Council of St. Patrick Catholic Church and former board member of St. Luke's United Methodist Church and the Lakeview Shepherd Center.

Jack served AAFA in several ways, including locating and mapping Louisiana cemetery locations and the AAFA photo archives which he established.
