"Lived in Washington Parish and reared a large family." - Tynes Diary Warren bought two tracts of land from the federal land office in Greensburg. Both were in township 3S, range 9E. June 1, 1858 he bought 74 acres in sections 26 & 27. July 1, 1859 he purchased 243 acres in sections 22 & 23.

Edwin died Mar 10 1878, Pike Co., MS. Edwin served as a Pvt. in Capt. Thos. Bickham's Co. 13th Regiment, Louisiana Militia; War 1812. Copy of military records on file with AAFA. He and Martha are supposed to be buried on what is, or was, the Eugene Smith farm but to the casual observer they appear to be buried on the highway right-of-way. Applicable dates taken from the gravestones. The book published on Pike Co. Cemeteries calls it the Edwin B. Alford Cemetery which is what will be used in this record.

His will was written July 14, 1768 and proved in the November 1771 session of the Bute County Court. The will was published in AAFA ACTION, Winter 1994 p. 30. In his will Julius makes his Brother Lodwick Alford, and his son James, the executors of his will.
